a fascinating and lively account of the lives of british warships named london looking at history from the perspective of the men who were there there is no current warship in the royal navy called hms london but vessels carrying the name have featured in some of the most controversial episodes of british naval history for example the wooden wall battleship hms london of the late 18th century could be called the ship that lost america while the heavy cruiser of ww2 was command vessel for the escort force that failed to safeguard the controversial convoy pq17 examining the stories of hms londons all the way from the english civil war through the battle of copenhagen in 1801 where nelson famously ignored signals to break off the action displayed by hms london we also learn of the pre dreadnought london s participation in the ill fated dardanelles campaign of ww1 among the people iain ballantyne interviewed for this book were veterans of the arctic convoys of ww2 the yangtse incident and warriors of the cold war and 1991 gulf war it all adds up to a thoroughly researched and exciting narrative of naval history adding to the authenticity of the tale iain even sailed to russia in the last hms london a type 22 guided missile frigate in august 1991 during a ww2 convoy re enactment the ship was almost hit by a practice torpedo launched from a soviet submarine and had to take evasive action

the biography of a british battleship from an author with a facility for rendering nonfiction into a narrative as brisk and readable as a novel historynet the second world war battleship hms rodney achieved lasting fame for her role in destroying the pride of hitler s navy the mighty bismarck in a thrilling duel the rodney carrying the largest guns ever mounted in a british warship finally succeeded in turning her

in 2002 the wreck of a british cruiser was located by divers off the coast of tunisia the stunning photographs of the wreck inspired dr richard osborne to delve into the controversy surrounding the loss of one of the royal navy s proudest ships hms manchester after taking part in the norway campaign of 1940 manchester was sent to the mediterranean where she was involved in the dangerous malta convoys on her first convoy she was struck by a torpedo and badly damaged in danger of sinking at any minute her skipper captain harold drew managed to save his ship her next operation was to prove her last in operation pedestal the vital malta relief convoy manchester was again hit by a torpedo this time rather than risk the lives of his crew drew decided to scuttle his ship for this drew was court martialled in what would become the longest such case in the history of the royal navy using the testimony of those involved the highly respected naval historian dr osborne pieces together one of the most intriguing stories to emerge from the second world war coupled with photographs of the wreck and a detailed account of its discovery the watery grave the life and death of hms manchester will shed new light on this remarkable tale

in 1961 the royal navy came up with a brilliant idea why not take all its rogues thugs and malcontents and place them on board its flagship hms bermuda where hard work and continuous exercising would keep them out of trouble joining this colourful crew was sixteen year old peter broadbent fresh out of his year s training at hms ganges and drafted to bermadoo to make up the ship s quota of junior seamen initially he lived a cocooned existence in the juniors mess with a community of cockroaches as his closest companions but his life changed dramatically the day he transferred to the notorious for d seamen s mess there he grew up in the course of his 34 000 nautical miles with bermuda he learned how to ammunition the ship avoid pompey lil sing the oggie song survive a storm throw a perfect heaving line and count himself proud to be a sharp end seaman on his eighteenth birthday the entire population of hamilton bermuda along with a uniformed band and full ceremonial enthusiastically welcomed peter and his ship in newcastle upon tyne he was given the job of preventing women wearing skirts from descending a long open backed ladder in stockholm he had a memorable dalliance with a local girl called gunnel and in amsterdam a professional businesswoman at work in canal street was so impressed with his performance that as he took his leave she shook his hand warmly and gave him some of her business cards

few would have thought in 1944 as hms cavalier entered service with the royal navy that over six decades later she would still be in existence the last example of the classic british wartime destroyer this book looks at the distinguished history of the vessel

hms cavalier is a c class destroyer one of 96 war emergency programme destroyers that were ordered between 1940 and 1942 she saw action on convoy duty off russia and later in 1945 was sent to the far east where she provided naval gunfire support during the battle of surabaya she continued with the british pacific fleet until may 1946 now designated as a war memorial to the 142 rn destroyers and 11 000 men lost during wwii she is on display at chatham historic dockyard as is the case for many museum ships there is a surprising shortage of informative and well illustrated guides for reference during a visit or for research by enthusiasts ship modellers naval buffs historians or students this book in the seaforth historic ship series redresses the gap containing more than 200 specially commissioned photographs the book takes the reader on a superbly illustrated tour of the ship from bow to stern and deck by deck significant parts of the vessel £ for example the gun turrets and engine rooms £ are given detailed coverage both in words and pictures so that the reader has at hand the most complete visual record and explanation of the ship that exists in addition the importance of the ship both in her own time and now as a museum vessel is explained no other book offers such superb visual impact nor brings the ship so vividly to life

hms agamemnon was a 64 gun ship of the line which in her 29 year career became one of the best known vessels of the royal navy commanded between 1793 and 1796 by horatio nelson who always referred to her as his favourite ship

this sweeping naval history chronicles the many british vessels to bare the name revenge from the sixteenth century galleon to the twentieth century submarine the glory years of the royal navy can be glimpsed between sir francis drake s revenge and the polaris submarine of the same name built four centuries later in its various forms revenge was at the armada the azores trafalgar and jutland and with weapons capable of terrible destruction the first revenge a 46 gun galleon launched in 1577 symbolized the boldness and flair of that period commanded by the legendary drake it was faster and more maneuverable than the massive spanish galleons many years later the mighty 25 000 ton battleship was representative of the strength of the british empire at its peak the first revenge would have comfortably fitted across the beam of this battleship more than a study of these mighty ships the story of the

hms revenge describes their commanders and crews as well illustrated throughout it captures the flavor of life on board and details technological developments and of course the actions in which they were involved
